From Hilton, Rockville to 600 Water Street, Washington DC (ship pier):

- Total fare: \$5.2 (peak-of-the-peak fare, recommend to purchase round trip fare: \$5.2 + \$2.75 = \$7.95)
- At Twin Brook metro station, take RED line toward Glenmont
- Transfer at Gallery Place-Chinatown to GREEN LINE toward Waterfront-SEU
- At the Waterfront SEU Station, Turn Right on M ST. which turns into Maine Ave. Turn Left onto 6th. Odyssey is located at Gangplank Marina, 6th and Water Street.

Note: From Twin Brook metro station to Gallery Place-Chinatown will take 28 minutes and from Gallery Place-Chinatown to Waterfront-SEU will take 6 minutes. For 6:00 pm boarding time, it is recommended to arrive at the Twin Brook metro station around 5:15-5:30 PM to allow a few minutes of waiting time.

From Water Street, Washington DC to Hilton, Rockville:

• Total fare: \$ 2.75 (off-peak fare)

- At Waterfront-SEU metro station, take GREEN LINE toward Gallery Place-Chinatown
- From Gallery Place-Chinatown, transfer to RED line toward Shady Grove
- On RED line, get off at the Twin Brook Station

Note: it is recommend to arrive at Waterfron-SEU metro station no later than 11:30 PM in order to catch up the last RED line train
